2. Find $\lim_{x \rightarrow -\infty} f(x)$ and $\lim_{x \rightarrow \infty} f(x)$. [1]
3. Find $f'(x)$. [1]
4. Find any and all critical points of $f(x)$. [0.5]
5. Find the absolute maximum and minimum values of $f(x)$. [1.5]
